New Directive for Group Leaders

GROUPS OF FIFTY OR MORE: READ NEW DIRECTIVE

****New Directive From the Conference Office:***

- All Groups are strongly advised to have one assistant Group leader for every 50 teens. This person would:
 1. Not have the role of chaperone but would oversee a *group* of fifty and their five chaperones;
 2. Assist the Group leader in gathering the paperwork, setting up the small groups, training small group leaders, and ministering to the chaperones and teens within the group assigned to them.

Example (using Assistant Group Leaders):

- 150 in a teen participants
 - 75 male
 - 75 female
- Requires:
 - 1 Group Leader, either gender
 - 2 assistant group leaders, preferable 1 Male and 1 Female
 - 15 Chaperones (half Male, half Female)
- Breaking into Small Groups (A small group should consist of 9-10 teens, no more than 10)
 - 15 Small Groups
 - Each group leader is responsible for training 5 chaperones and overseeing 5 small groups

Meeting and processing with the small group leaders/chaperones can be done by the group leader and assistant group leaders. This will allow much more to be covered and addressed during the weekend.
